

ALUMNAE DIRECTORY FAQS FOR AOII/PCI RELATIONSHIP

1. I received an email/postcard/phone call from a company asking for my personal information. They said they were working on a directory for Alpha Omicron Pi Fraternity.

Is this a legitimate project, or is it a scam?

We have partnered with PCI (also known as Publishing Concepts) to produce our new alumnae directory. PCI is a company located in Dallas, TX and Virginia Beach, VA that publishes directories for educational institutions, fraternities, sororities and military organizations across the nation. This project allows Alpha Omicron Pi Fraternity to receive important updates to our database so we know more about our alumnae and how we can better serve you and future alumnae.

2. How do I know my information will only be used for directory purposes?

Alpha Omicron Pi Fraternity has a contractual agreement with PCI that states:

- **a.** The names, addresses and information provided to PCI by Alpha Omicron Pi Fraternity for the publication of the directory will be held confidential by PCI, except to the extent that they are utilized in, or in the preparation of, the directory and except as required by court order or law.
- **b.** The directory will be made available only to alumnae of Alpha Omicron Pi Fraternity. Upon completion of the project, PCI will return to Alpha Omicron Pi Fraternity any and all electronic files that have been supplied to Alpha Omicron Pi Fraternity or produced by PCI in connection with the production of the directory.

3. I would like to verify and update my information. How may I do this?

If you have received a postcard or an email with a telephone number, you may call the number to speak with a dedicated representative for the Alpha Omicron Pi Fraternity project. The representative will verify all the information we have on file for you and make any updates where needed.



If you have received an email with an embedded link, you may go to the online site to review your information. If you have questions, you may call PCI's customer service desk at 1-800-982-1590.

4. Can anyone purchase a directory?

This Alpha Omicron Pi Fraternity alumnae publication is available for sale only to Alpha Omicron Pi Fraternity alumnae.

5. Can I choose some or all of my information not to be printed in the directory?

When you call to update your information, you can tell the representative what information you would prefer to have excluded. You may also communicate this information to the PCI customer service desk (1-800-982-1590).

6. I ordered a directory/package over the phone and would like to cancel my order. How do I do this?

Call the PCI customer service help desk at 1-800-982-1590, and they will take care of this for you.
